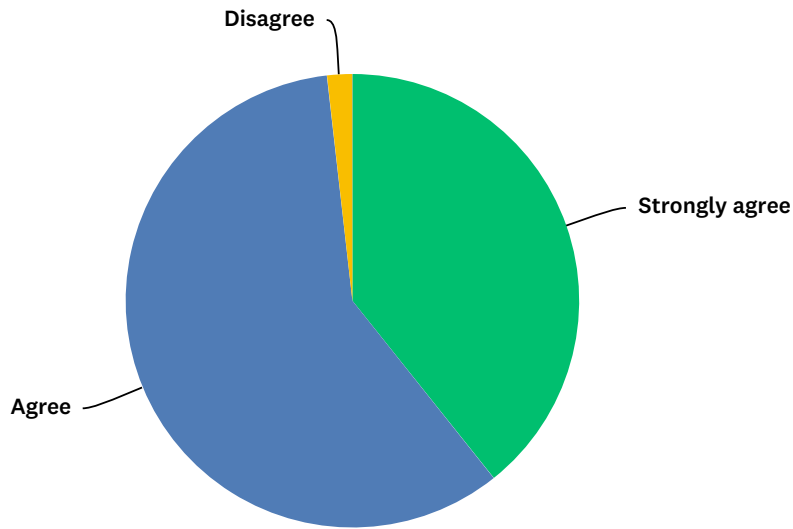

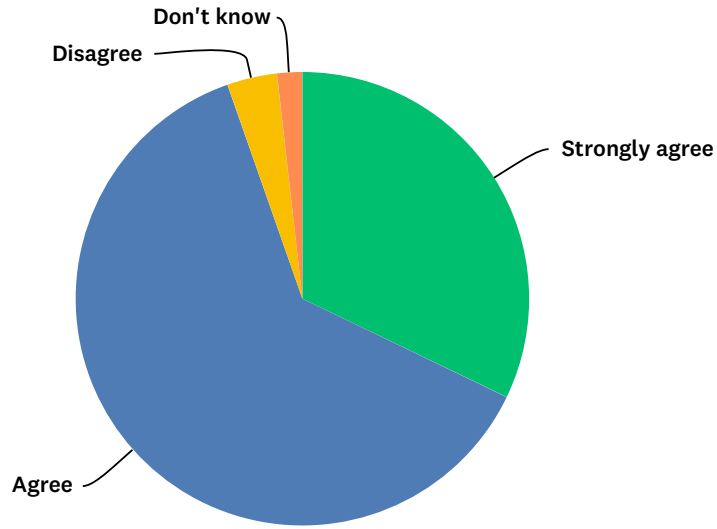

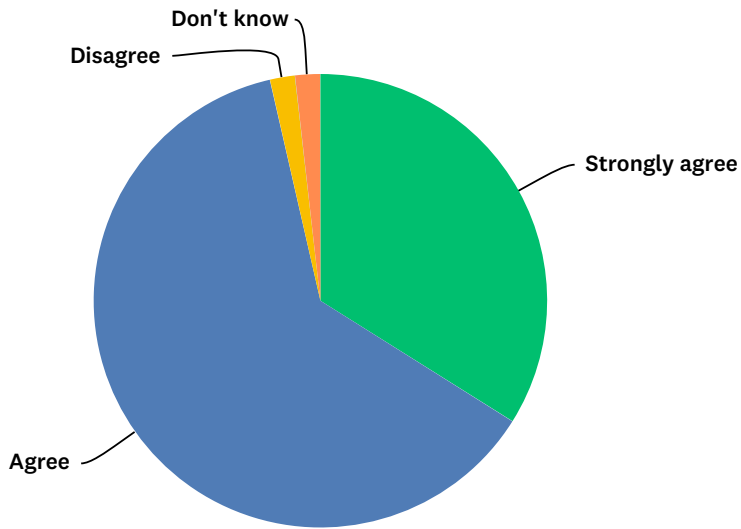

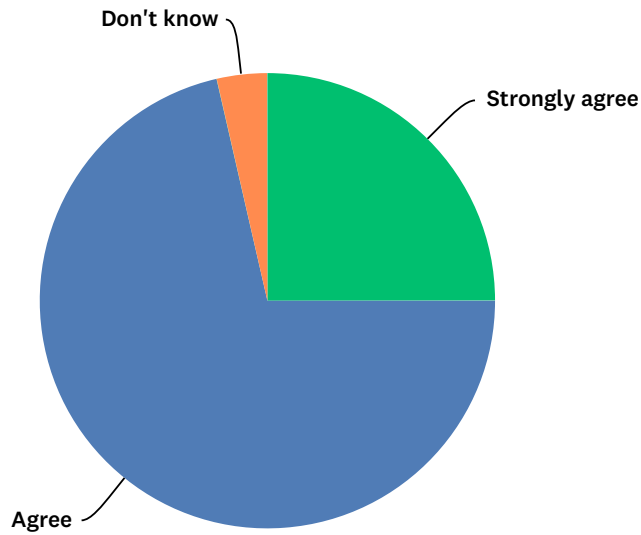

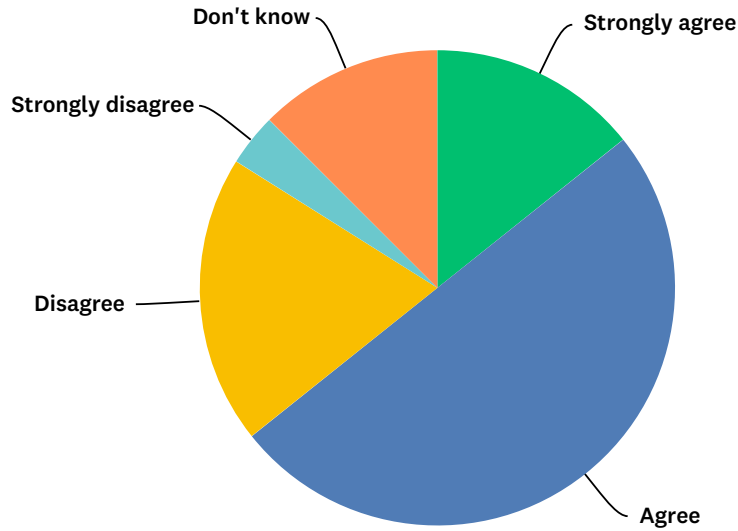

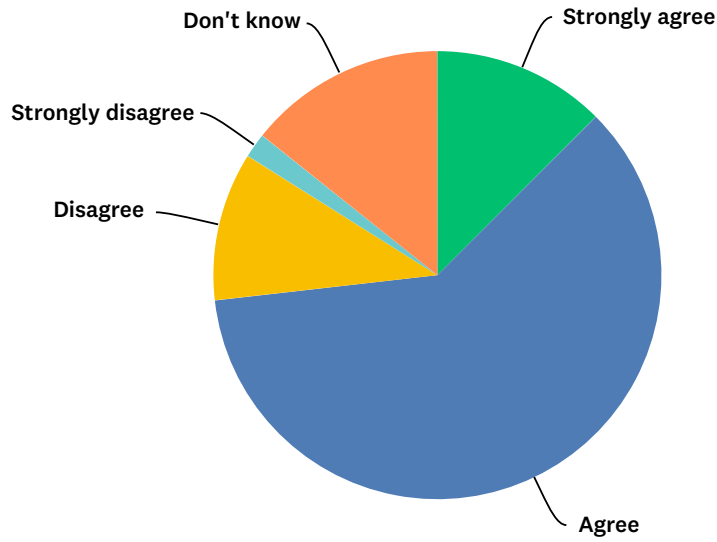
Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age

Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved

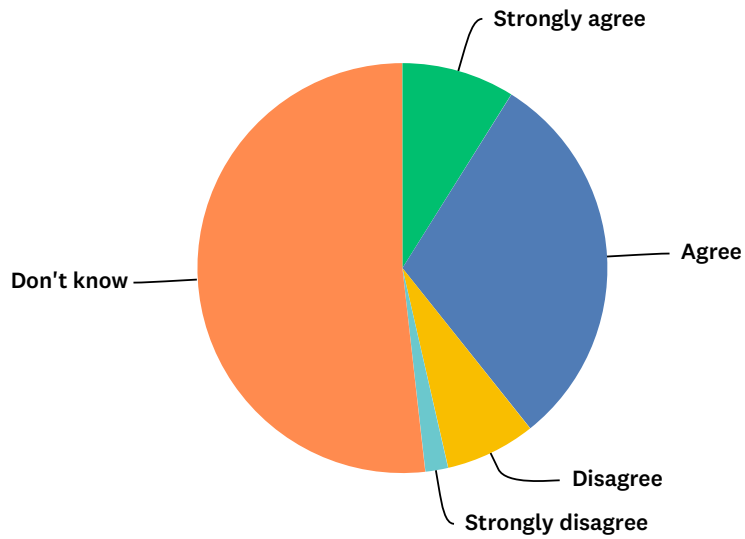

Q8 This school deals effectively with bullying

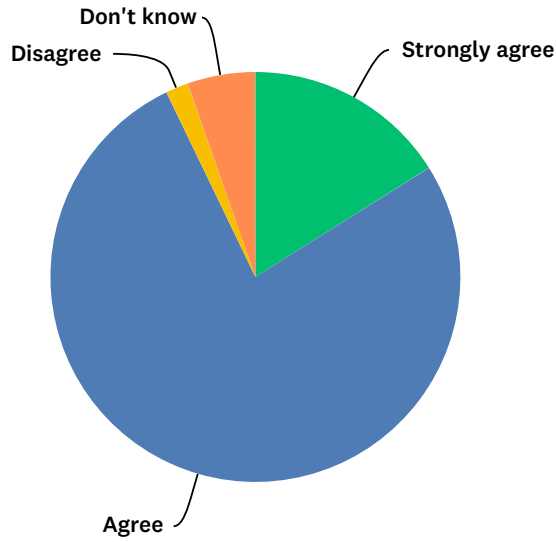

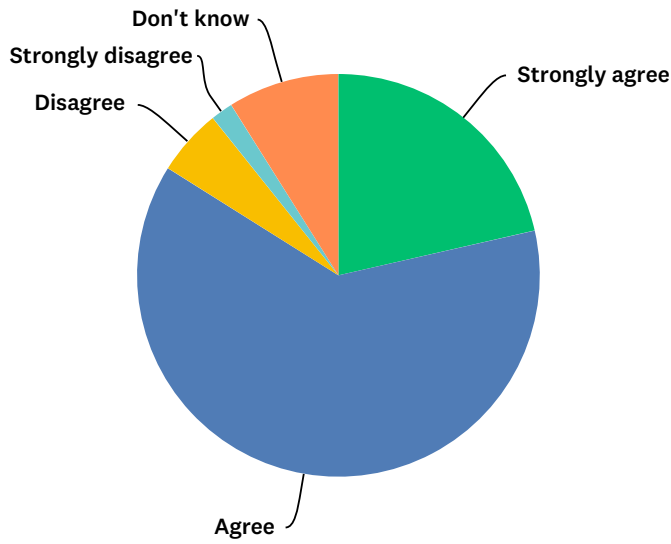

Q10 This school responds well to any concerns I raise

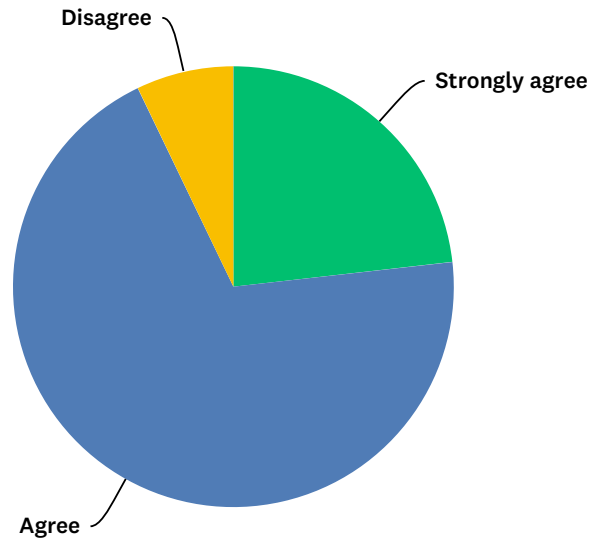

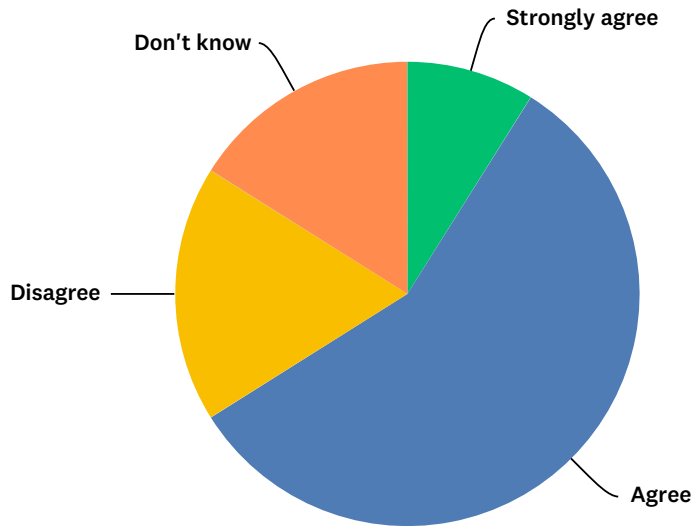

Q12 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction within school.

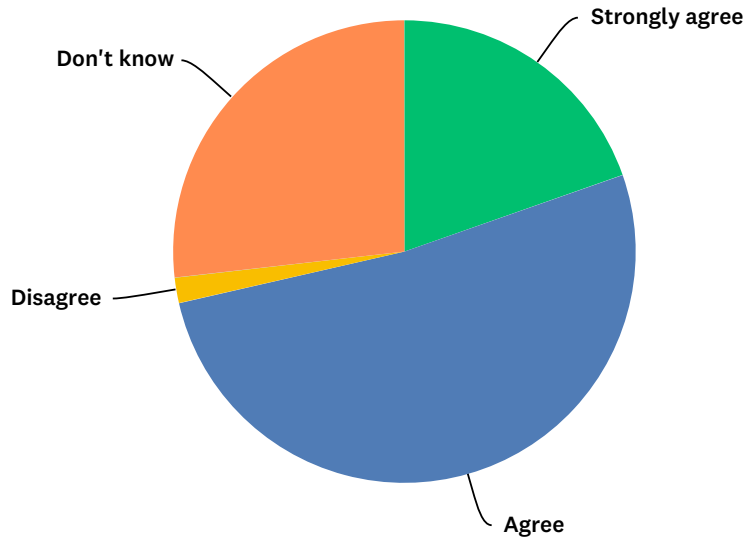

Q13 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support.

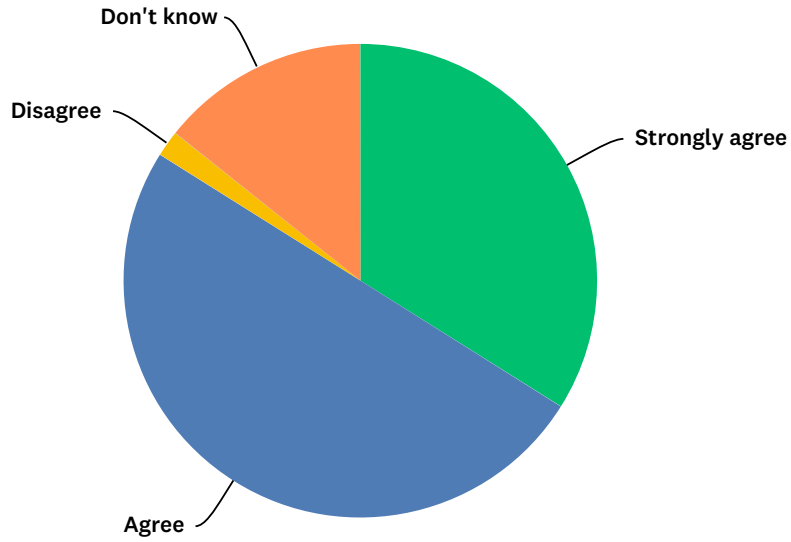

Q14 Would you recommend this school to another parent?

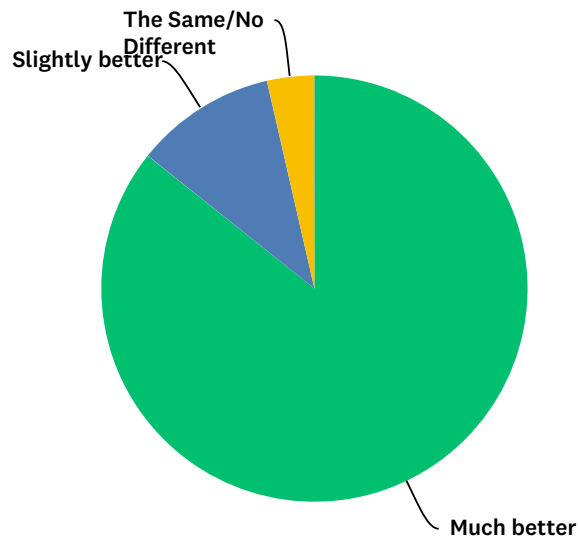

Question 15 Summary – Comments on the layout/format of the parents’ evening:

Of the 56 parents who responded to this question, 85.71% of them said it was much better, with 10.71% noting it was slightly better. Parents commented it was a much more relaxed, less claustrophobic and there was more room to sit. Some did comment on the 5minute appointment time not always being adhered to by parents and teachers.

Q16 Summary - Elaboration on any of the answers you have given to Q1-Q2:

Of the 6 parents who responded to this question, insufficient homework being given, disruptive pupils within lessons affecting their child’s learning and difficulty in communicating with staff about pupil welfare were noted. Being happy with the school was also commented.

Q17 – Summary – What do you as parents like most about the school:

9 out of 56 parents responded to this question and all responded positively. Parents commented on how understanding, supportive and encouraging staff were and how issues were dealt with well. The relatively small class sizes were noted as a positive.

Q18 Summary - What areas do you feel the school could improve:

10 parents chose to answer this question, the responses were based on instilling values more readily within school, the need to publish the school lunch menu in order for parents to view it, an increase in homework being necessary and more pupil welfare advice needed. Water fountains rather than plastic bottles were made as a suggestion.

Q19 Summary – ‘Further comments’:

The vast majority of comments were positive, with one parent requesting confirmation of option choices be quicker.

Overall Summary

From the survey responses, it is pleasing to report the vast majority of year 9 parents/carers report their child feels happy & safe at school, they make good progress, are taught well and are well looked after. The school understands this is not unanimous and endeavours to always improve and build upon foundations created. The school will continue to monitor and explore ideas to tackle behavioural matters and homework concerns. Our quality assurance procedures and review policies will be followed to enable this to happen.

From question 8, 39% of the parents agreed or strongly agreed bullying was dealt with effectively. It should also be noted that 52% of parents did not know whether the school dealt effectively with bullying, this could be due to the fact that the majority of children do not experience bullying at school. In support of this only 1 parent disagreed the school provides good student wellbeing advice and support. 84% of parents would recommend the school to another parent.
