General Certificate in Manx – Teisht Chadjin Ghaelgagh

This qualification is equivalent to a GCSE award. It is written and marked in consultation with CCEA, the awards body of Northern Ireland.

Subject Content

My Ellan – My Island

Traa Seyr – Leisure Time

Scoill, Obbyr as Laghyn Seyrey – School, Work and Holidays

Eggey Vannin Jiu – Manx Society Today

Resources

The Course Organiser will provide all books, sound files and learning materials.

How is the Course Assessed?

Students will complete a minimum of three pieces of coursework in written Manx, one of which is to be presented orally, and another to be written under exam conditions. There is an additional oral exam, a listening paper and a reading paper.

Deadlines:

All tests and coursework should be completed by the end of term 3.

There are four elements of controlled assessment to be completed during the course. Candidates are allowed two weeks to complete each task.

What is Expected of the Student?

Students will have studied Manx at Key Stage 3 and have a strong commitment to furthering their knowledge of the language. Extra-curricular lessons may be available.
