

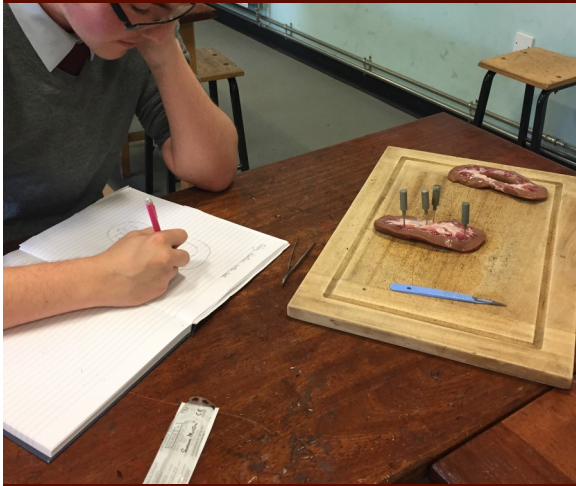

Dear Student

Now that GCSE examinations are finished, you may be thinking about next term. We hope that students will consider returning to our school. This document is designed to offer information relating to the options columns for next year and the enrolment process. Information about our entry policy and sixth form life is available on the school website.

Collaboration with Ramsey Grammar and Castle Rushen High Schools has allowed us to offer a wide range of subjects and Level 3 qualifications for September 2019. The majority of these lessons will be taught at QEII High School; however, students may need to travel to other Centres for some lessons. Where this is the case, transportation will be provided. Further information can be obtained in the Collaboration Handbook.

Collaboration also means that if the option columns at QEII do not allow you to select one of your preferred choices, we may be able to accommodate your choice with one of the other schools.

Please note that IGCSE Results will be published on Tuesday 13th August. All other GCSE results will be published on Thursday 22nd August. Members of staff from both QEII and UCM will be available on the 22nd August to offer support and guidance and there will be additional local careers workshops available.

We will be holding interviews for admission to the 6th Form on Friday 23rd August. Enrolment information packs will be available on the school website. Hard copies may be obtained from the school office or collected on GCSE Results days. Any student who is unavailable for an interview on the above date may be interviewed by arrangement at a different date.

Please note: If students are unable to collect their results in person they must provide the school with written consent to release their results to a named individual or provide a stamped addressed envelope in advance so that results may be posted home.

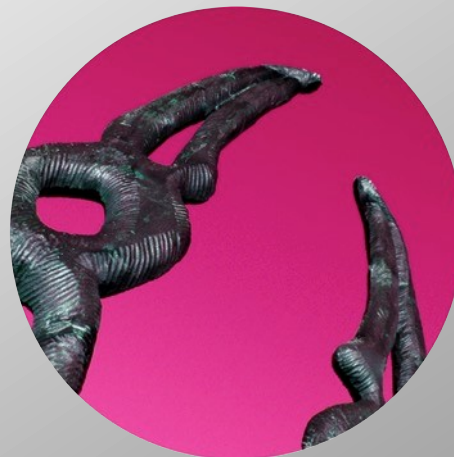
Options Columns

Below are the Key Stage 5 options columns for September 2019
We recommend that most students choose 3 options (maximum one subject from each column).

Highlighted subjects are part of a collaborative programme with Castle Rushen High School and Ramsey Grammar School (see table below for details).

Further information relating to travel to and from other Centres will be published in the Collaboration Handbook. Where practical, students will use public service buses. Where this is the case, the cost of this will be met by the Department. Where this is not possible, other forms of transport will be provided (minibus or taxi).

Where students cannot select their preferred 3 choices it may be possible to study a non-collaborative subject at either Castle Rushen or Ramsey Grammar School. For more information on this please speak to Mr Coole, Mr Slack or Miss Delaney.
