
Q3 My child makes good progress at this school







Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?





Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?





Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise



Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school



Overall Summary

From the 36 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that over 97% of year 12 and 13 parents/carers report their child feels happy & safe at school, are well looked after, make good progress and receive appropriate homework. The majority of parents believe the school makes sure its pupils are well behaved, responds to concerns raised and provides good student wellbeing and advice. Only 2 parents felt they did not receive valuable information about their child's progress, however the strong majority believed their child was taught well and would recommend the school to another parent.

1 parent said their child was verbally bullied and that it had been dealt with effectively. This is pleasing to note as the Bullying Policy has recently been reviewed and updated.

11% of parents were not aware of their child's current attendance. Form tutors have now spoken with their tutees to inform them of their attendance data. Students should communicate this information back to parents/carers. 4 parents felt their child was unable to study effectively without distraction. The key stage 5 team have addressed this and have given students multiple options of where to study. For those year 12 students who receive a '1' for attitude to learning on their reports, the option of signing in and working in an area which is not R&R can do so. Year 13 have a designated study room and are allowed to request a free room if they wish to work elsewhere.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
