about Anti-bullying week.

The basic layout of the three lessons are;

## Lesson 1

## Starter

Think about words associated with bullying. This can lead to a mind map on the whiteboard. I also link in that bullying isn't just something in school, it can happen at work, in nursing homes, in families, at home etc. The next 3 lessons will be prepare, create and rehearse idea and then mini tutor group competition for the best performance in each class will be invited to perform on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November at Lunchtime in front of judges and the other finalists!

Main 1 You can use a story from NSPCC or this TED Talk https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=sa1iS1MgUy4

I usually get them into a circle and share a bit of my Yr 7-9 journey in school and bullying that happened. The TED talk takes about 12 minutes, but it's worth a watch.

Main 2

The different things you can produce, it could be choral speaking, dancing, rap, a song, a mini narrated drama. To show you some examples;

Main Activity (Devising)

Get into groups and mindmap your ideas and get them agreed with the teacher, let them start devising.

Highlight good work!

Plenary Set targets for next lesson and even if they are going to get together and rehearse.

Lesson 3/4 Starter – Warm Up

Main Activity - Rehearing and Performances, with mini AFL evaluations!

By the end of this lesson film any work which is finished and get them to vote for the one they want in the competition – with a vote from you as the staff member.  $\textcircled$ Also in invite them all to come on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November at 1.15pm to the final !
