



Q1 My child is happy at this school







Q5 My child is taught well at this school



Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age



Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?










Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise

Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school



Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support





Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





Of the 7 parents who responded to this question, all responses were positive. Excellent communication with parents, lots of new opportunities for their children to access, zero-tolerance to bullying and very inclusive provision were some of the comments made.

Of the 4 who answered this question, the volume of homework being greater was commented on the most. The homework policy has been reviewed and a homework timetable has now been established.

Overall Summary

From the 34 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that the vast majority of year 7 parents/carers note their child feels happy and safe at school, are well looked after, are taught well and make good progress, can study without distraction and are provided with good student wellbeing advice and guidance. 2 parents disagreed that their child received appropriate homework for their age. As noted above, the homework policy has recently been reviewed and a homework timetable has been put in place. 7 parents/carers noted they were not aware of their child's attendance or of the grades their child was currently working at. Following on from a discussion with the Key Stage 3 tutor team about this, students are now given conduct stickers containing information about attendance, achievement points and behaviour points once a half term to stick into their planners. The reports issued to parents/carers also include current working grades and attendance information, however tutors will make parents/carers aware of this when meeting with them at the tutor evening in September.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
