At Drama Club you can develop your acting skills, take part in performances, have fun, make new friends and be creative!

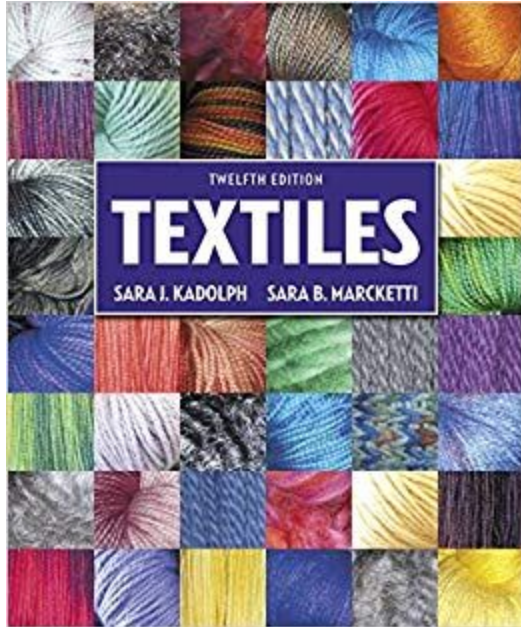
Drama club takes place at 1.30pm Thursday lunch time. When we are rehearsing for a bigger project/play some rehearsals will be after school. All year groups are welcome!

Anyone who plays a wind, brass or percussion instrument is very welcome. The band plays a wide variety of music including film music, pop and rock classics, traditional Manx/ Celtic music and everything in between! The band regularly performs both at school events such as the Christmas Concert, Carol Service and Prize Night and out in the community at summer concerts in local primary schools.

We regularly perform in the annual Manx Music Festival and have regularly been awarded a 'distinction' by the adjudicator. The highlight of the band year is our annual concert with the Isle of Man Wind Orchestra where the evening concludes with both bands (over 80 musicians!) performing together.
