

## Notes with Plans – for Lang/Lit classes (Year 10)

- Longer has been given for the ‘writing’ sections as skills will need to be embedded as they are now assessed through exam
- Whilst there has to be one assessed piece of work at the end of a unit, other, short pieces should be marked to enable students to make progress
- Feedback/re-draft times have been built in to allow students to build on their skills
- There is some flexibility in term 2 – less time could be spent on initial exam prep if a week more is needed for Lit cw
- These plans do not include homework. A reminder that homework should be set weekly.

### NB

- For Lang – the changes to the exam paper means that there is only one specimen paper. **This paper will be used for this cohorts YEAR 11 MOCK.** I will have to make one up for Year 10
- That means papers will need to be made up for exam practice. I will be able to do some but I can’t do everything – so you will need to plan ahead and develop your own papers for practice.
- (Some sections are similar, but students will need to know how the paper fits together)
- For Lit, the poetry changes so there will be no pre-existing resources to support the teaching of poetry – nor any existing past papers. Again we are going to have to make them up – again, plan ahead!
- This will be the same for some novel and drama choices
