

Senior Prize Giving

On Thursday 12th September we held our annual Senior Prize Giving to celebrate the success of students in Years 11 and 13.

In our 40th anniversary year, we were delighted to welcome our Guest of Honour for the evening, His Excellency Sir Richard Gozney, KCMG, CVO, The Lieutenant Governor, to present the prizes.

Ms Moore thanked the sponsors, without whose generosity there would be no prizes, and was proud to share that this year has once again been hugely successful, both in terms of examination results and in the wider aspects of education. She congratulated all of the prize winners and also those who have achieved external qualifications.

This year around ³/₄ of GCSE examinations taken were awarded a grade C or above, with ¹/₄ gaining top A*/A grades. 64% of students gained 5 Cs or above including Maths and English. 80% of students achieved their C or above in Maths and 78% in English. 23 students achieved at least 5 A*/A grades, which is outstanding!

A Level results were also excellent, with 99.2% of entries gaining a pass grade. A special mention goes to Nathan Harmer, Amy Anderson, Rhys Owen and Kyle Short who all achieved exceptional results!
