



Q1 My child is happy at this school








Q4 My child is well looked after at this school



Q5 My child is taught well at this school



Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age



Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



Q8 This school deals effectively with bullying



Q9 This school is well led and managed



Q10 This school responds well to any concerns I raise





Q11 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q12 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





Q18 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying (please tick all that apply)?



Q16 Summary - 'What do you as parents like most about the school?'

There were 15 responses to this question (out of 48 completed surveys). 4 comments praised the variety of extra-curricular clubs/ activities. The remainder were a variety of highly positive comments on the approachability of staff and the happy, community environment of the school.

Q17 Summary - 'What areas do you feel the school could improve?'

There were 12 responses to this question. There were 2 comments about the organisation of parent's evening. One asked about using rooms rather than the hall for parent's evenings to spread parents out more. To that end, we are hoping to use the library and/ or the dining room as extra space in the future. The other asked about an on-line booking system for appointments and this will be looked into. Another 2 comments referenced how much notice was given to parents about school events and sporting fixtures. School events are placed in the school calendar in July every year (for the following year) and can be accessed via the school website (www.qe2.sch.im). However, we will try to publicise this more to parents and carers in the future. With regard to sports fixtures, the PE department endeavour to email sporting fixtures out to parents in all year groups at the start of each term. Fixture lists are also published on the QEII Sport Facebook page, the PE department notice boards, and on 'it's learning' for students to consult. Unfortunately, it is not always possible to confirm actual teams for events until a day or two before events due to availability of players but the PE staff always try to let students know as far in advance of the match as possible.

Overall Summary

From the survey responses, it is pleasing to report that the overwhelming majority of year 7 parents/ carers report that their child feels happy & safe at school (both 98%), that they are well looked after, are being taught well and are making good progress (all 100%) etc.

From question 8, 16% of parents felt the school could deal with bullying more effectively (46% felt it was dealt with effectively). However, when considering these statistics, it should also be noted that 40% of parents did not know whether the school dealt effectively with bullying which is highly possibly due to the fact that the majority of children do not experience bullying at school and therefore do not have it 'dealt with'. On the supplementary questions on bullying (Q17 to 21), 6 parents (out of 48 completed surveys) reported that their child had received some kind of bullying in the last 12 months with verbal, physical and cyber bullying were in approximately equal proportions. Of the 2 respondents who didn't report the incident to the school, they said they had dealt with it themselves. Similarly, 98% of parents feel their child is happy/ safe at school that again, one would hope reflects the relatively small amount of bullying which takes place in school. Nevertheless, the school realises that there is still work to do on both preventing and dealing with bullying effectively and is currently in the midst of reviewing it's policies and procedures on the matter and an update will be provided to all parents later in the school year.
