







Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age





Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved





Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?





Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying? Answered: 35 Skipped: 6









Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school





Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support





Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





Q20 What do you as parents like most about the school?

Of the 16 parents who responded to this question, the majority commented on the excellent methods of communication the school has. The schools zero tolerance to bullying, approachable staff, involvement in the community and the encouragement for every child to reach their potential were also noted. One parent was exceptionally pleased with the amount of sporting opportunities available to their child.

Q21 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

Of the 4 who answered this question, further clarity on the amount of homework given to students was requested by the majority. In response to this, the homework policy was reviewed and amended in 2018/2019. This policy has been updated and is on the school's website, along with the latest version of the homework timetable.

1 individual requested student council have more of a say of what happens in school. The student council have been visible, delivering assemblies and meeting weekly. This academic year they have actioned on anti-bullying advice, charity work and liaised with the catering manager to reduce single plastics usage in the canteen.

Parents thanked the school for bringing in the mobile phone ban.

Overall Summary

From the 41 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that all respondents noted their child/ward feels safe in school. Over 85% of parents noted their child is taught well, makes good progress, is happy and well looked after at school and receives the correct wellbeing advice and support. Communication is noted as exceptionally positive. The vast majority of parents said they were

aware of their child's current working grades and the school responds well to concerns raised. However, we appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues such as wellbeing and support through our internal quality assurance procedures and review policy as appropriate during the year.

Students being well behaved and studying without distraction was a concern for 8 parents. With this in mind the schools' behaviour policy is followed by staff and pupils are aware of sanctions and rewards in place.
