









Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age




Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved







Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?





Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?







Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise





Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress






Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support


Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?

7 parents responded to this question. Comments such as the school being able to deal with concerns effectively, high standards, great opportunities, fantastic sense of community, the variety of clubs available and an effective reporting method were noted.

Q20 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

Of the 3 who answered this question, one parent would like the school to handle bullying more effectively and two parents would like no homework or more meaningful homework to be given. Homework is given for a variety of reasons, namely to stretch and challenge, consolidate knowledge, encourage independent learning and give parents an opportunity to play an active role in their child's education. Each department is responsible for giving appropriate homework.

Overall Summary

From the 40 survey responses, it is pleasing to report 90% or above of parents report their child is happy and well looked after at school, makes good progress and is taught well. Whilst the strong majority of parents feel their child is safe, receive valuable information about progress, and know their current working grade.

75% of parents know their child's attendance data, to increase this awareness Form Tutors have been asked to inform all pupils of their current attendance percentage.

The majority of parents noted their child received the appropriate amount of homework. The homework policy has recently been reviewed and can be found, along with the homework allocations on our school website.

74% of parents agreed the school provided good wellbeing, advice and support, with no parents disagreeing. Currently at QEII we have introduced a new listening service 'Isle Listen' to enable the students to seek pastoral support, help and guidance when needed.

9 parents noted their child had been a victim of verbal or physical bullying, with all bar 3 parents noting the situation had been handled well. There is no place for bullying at QEII High School, both staff and students work together to support this notion. The School has recently been awarded Diana Award Status and has anti-bullying ambassadors.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
