



Q1 My child is happy at this school





Q2 My child feels safe at this school







Q4 My child is well looked after at this school







Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age





Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved





Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?





Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?







Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise





Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school





Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support





Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





Q20 What do you as parents like most about the school?

Of the 8 parents who responded to this question, varied responses were given. Parents commented on the approachable teachers, the excellent balance of academic and social curriculum and the welcoming environment the school offers. The level of communication and the variety of clubs available was thought to be a strength too.

Q21 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

3 parents commented on this question. The need for facilities to be updated, a receipt of emails sent and better general communication were noted. In response to these comments, the STEM Block is in the 'planning stage' and once built will offer a modern science and technology block. With regards to responses to emails, an automated system of responding to parents informing school their child is ill, is being looked into. At present we do not respond to these emails. Communication is via the student, email, the school website and social media. Parents can be notified by text should they wish this to be a method of communication.

2 parents noted their children were very happy at QEII High School.

Overall Summary

From the 40 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that 90% and above of year 8 parents/carers report their child feels happy & safe at school, makes good progress, are taught well and are well looked after. The vast majority noted their child receives appropriate amounts of homework and that the school is well led and managed and would recommend it to another parent. Communication was raised as a positive from parents/carers, as the majority thought the school responds well to concerns raised and that they receive valuable information from school about their child's progress.

70% of parents knew their child's attendance data. The Key Stage 3 team have been notified of this and as a result they will run weekly attendance reports and send to tutors to discuss with their tutees.

10 respondents noted their child had been a victim of bullying, of which all bar 3 parents confirmed the bullying had been dealt with effectively. However, it must be noted that the school takes bullying very seriously. The pastoral and PSHE schemes of work have been rewritten and incorporate anti-bullying. Year 8 addressed bullying during Anti-Bullying Week, in order to raise awareness of strategies to tackle it.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
