



Q1 My child is happy at this school





Q2 My child feels safe at this school









Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?






Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?






Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise



Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress







Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support





Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





17 parents/carers responded to this question. A caring, supportive, positive environment with fantastic, approachable staff were noted upon numerous times. The exceptional amount of extra-curricular activities and excellent tutor/pupil/parent relationship, involving good communication was also commented on.

Q20 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

Of the 5 who answered this question better communication to parents/carers for after school activities was requested, as were more vegetarian options at dinnertime. The extra-curricular programme is on the school's website and Itslearning page for all to view. Our Catering Manager has used our social media platform to request ideas for parents/carers of vegetarians/vegans and those with allergies to contact her at school. The catering team are always looking for ideas on how to improve their variety of meals available.

Q21 Any further comments

6 positive comments were made, these included thanking the school for such a positive start to their children's secondary education and how impressed they were with QEII High School.

Overall Summary

From the 57 survey responses it is pleasing to report the vast majority of parents reported their child is happy, safe, well looked after and is provided with good student wellbeing advice and support.

88% and above of parents noted their child makes good progress, is taught well and receives appropriate homework.

The majority of parents/carers agreed the school was well led and managed, responded well to concerns raised and felt their child was able to study effectively without distraction.

77% of parents/carers noted they were aware of the grades their child is working at. Throughout the year there are 3 formal points of contact for parents to be made aware of how their child is progressing. However, teachers are always willing to speak to parents about their child's progress, should it be requested.

9 parents said their child had been a victim of bullying (verbal, physical and 1 cyber), all bar 2 parents noted it had been dealt with effectively. We take bullying very seriously and endeavour to do our upmost in dealing with every reported incident effectively.

56% of parents said they were aware of their child's attendance data. Following on from a discussion with the Key Stage 3 tutor team about this, students are now given stickers containing information about their attendance and number of behaviour and achievement points once a half term to stick into their planners.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
