









Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age



Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?



Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?



Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?




Q11 This school is well led and managed


Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise

Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress



Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school




Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support




Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?


Q17 Are you aware of your child's current percentage attendance at school?

Q20 What do you as parents like most about the school?

18 parents responded to the question, giving a wide range of positives about the school. These included; the variety of subject content, lunchtime clubs, exceptional communication with swift responses, the use of Google Classroom to assist with learning, the kindness and respect students are treated with, faces and names are known, progress of students, welcoming atmosphere, safe environment in which children are well looked after and that their education is of the utmost importance.

Q21 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

Of the 12 who answered this question, half related to homework. Some parents would like more and some less homework, better communication of homework was requested and for homework to be always placed on Google Classroom. Other comments made included a better explanation of levels and a reduction in the cost of PE uniform.

In response to these points; homework is in place to challenge, consolidate and encourage students to work independently, further homework can always be requested on an individual basis and quality not quantity is the emphasis placed on homework given. Many homework's are placed on Google Classroom, however due to the nature of the homework given, this may not always be possible. The use of the student planner is the preferred means of noting down homework, as it is easily accessible for the student, teacher, tutor and parent to view how much/what homework has been given.

With regards to levels, each subject provides students with level descriptors for topics covered, this is often stuck into their exercise books at the start of new units for students and parents to refer to.

The School has been in contact with local suppliers as to the cost of PE kit sold and to clarify what kit is necessity, what is optional and what needs to be QEII branded.

Q22 Any further comments

1 parent praised transition process and another thanked the school for respecting their religious belief.

Overall Summary

From the 53 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that over 87% of respondents noted their child/ward felt happy and safe in school, was well looked after, made good progress and was taught well. Over 92% of parents said the school was well managed, responded well to concerns raised and that they received valuable information about their child's progress.

Of those who reported their child had been bullied at school (verbally and physically), all bar 1 noted it had been dealt with effectively. Only 5 respondents felt their child couldn't study effectively without distraction in school, this is pleasing to note as the CPD team have recently addressed this matter. The majority of parents felt their child received the appropriate amount of homework, the homework policy will be reviewed as per the school calendar.

The school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures and review policy as appropriate during the year.
