



Q1 My child is happy at this school







Q3 My child makes good progress at this school





Q4 My child is well looked after at this school





Q5 My child is taught well at this school



Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age





Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?









Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress





Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school





Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support





Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?





One respondent noted the school dealt with Covid-19 lockdowns excellently well and thanked the teachers for adapting their lessons and supporting their child.

Overall Summary

From the 20 survey responses, it is pleasing to report 90% or above of parents note that the school responds well to concerns made, their child makes good progress and is happy, safe and well looked in school. Whilst the strong majority of parents would recommend the school to another parent, feel the school is well led and managed, know their child's current attendance and working grade and feel their child is able to study without distraction.

4 parents noted their child had been a victim of verbal, cyber or physical bullying, with 1 parent stating the situation had been handled well. There is no place for bullying at QEII High School, both staff and students work together to support this notion. The school has anti-bullying ambassadors and a comprehensive anti-bullying policy which it follows.

2 parents stated their child was not able to study effectively without distraction and 1 parent noted their child did not receive appropriate homework for their age. During the first half term in year 9 the tutor scheme of work reflects on self-learning and revision tasks/techniques, enabling students to self-study in the evenings should no specific homework be set. The school also follows a homework policy which is available on our website.

95% of respondents agreed that if their child had to self-isolate, they were aware of how to access online learning resources.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
