

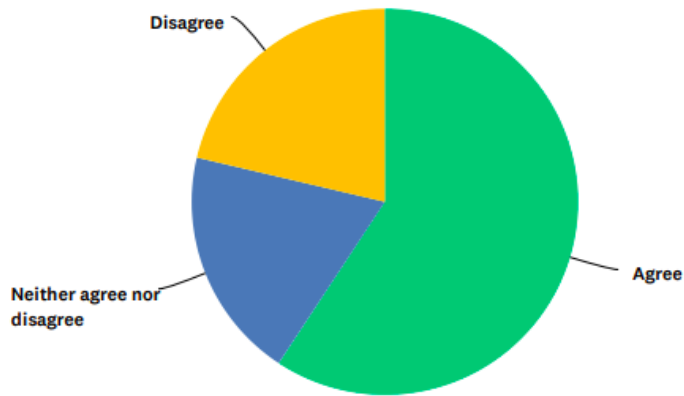

Q1 My child's primary school effectively prepared them for secondary school life

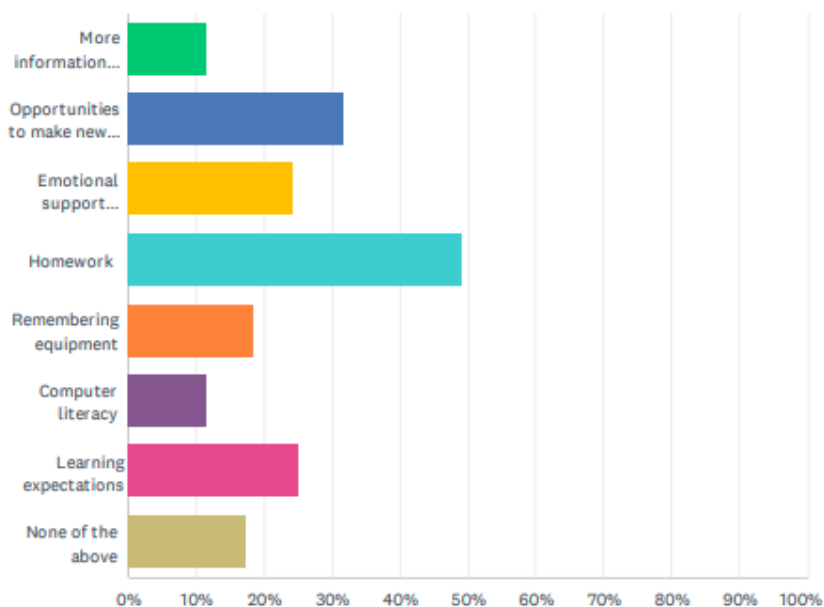

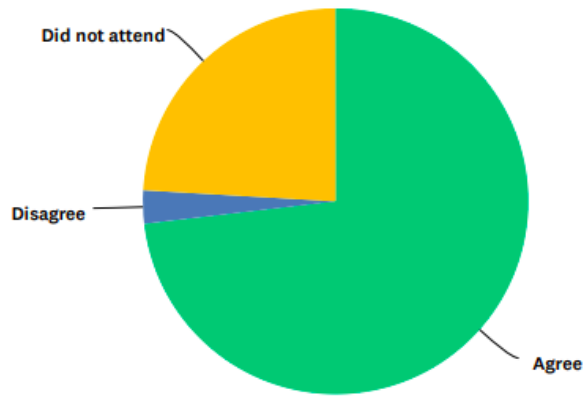

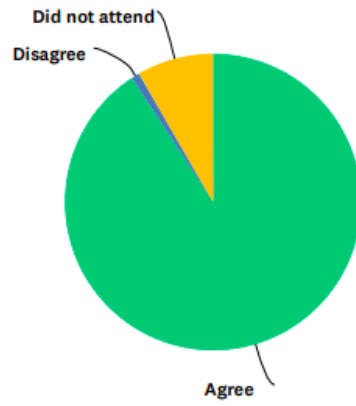

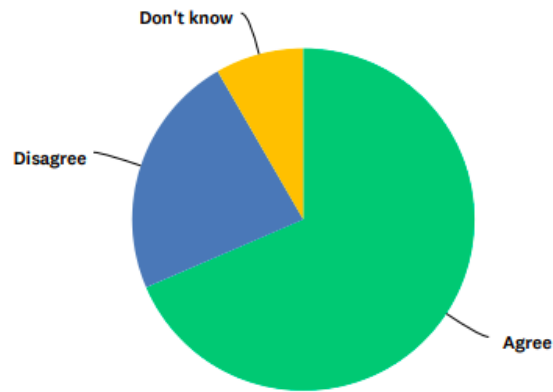

Q6 Do you think your child had enough opportunities, given the Covid-19 circumstances, to attend different transition events at QEII High School

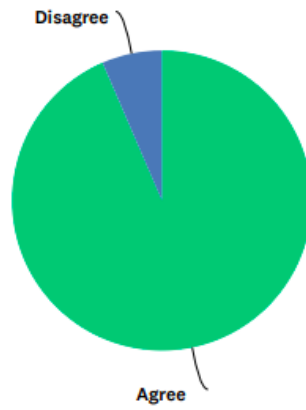

Q7 My child has settled into QEII High School well

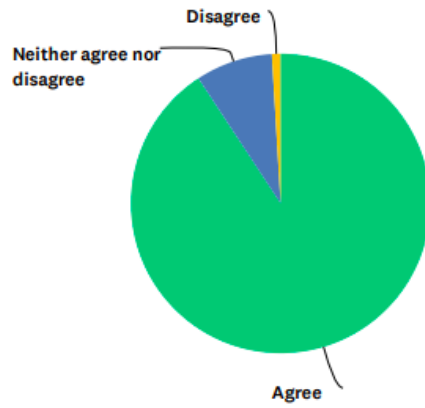

Q8 My child shows an interest in their learning at QEII High School

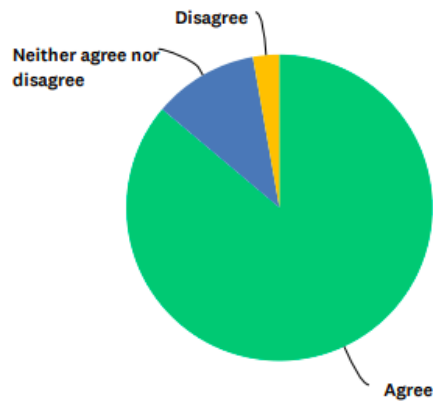

Q9 My child enjoys coming to school most days

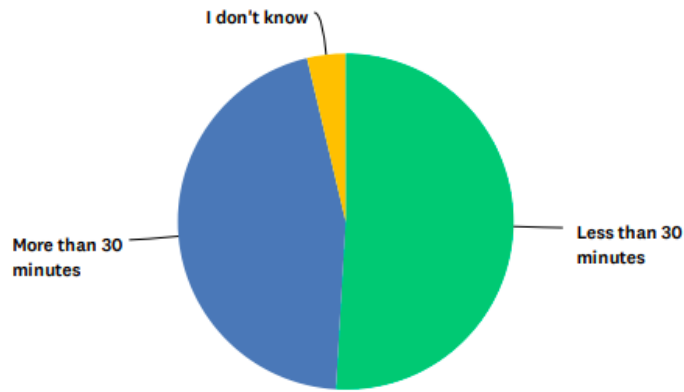

Overall Summary

108 parents responded to the Year 7 transition survey, with the majority feeling they were well informed about transition events available to their child. The strong majority of parents also noted the Roadshows provided a useful source of information about the transition process. The Welcome Evening proved to be a huge success, with only 1 parent not finding it informative.

The survey suggests that year 7 have settled into QEII well, with the strong majority of parents noting their child enjoys coming to school and is interested in their learning.

59% of parents agreed that their child's primary school effectively prepared them for secondary school life, however homework and opportunities to make new friends were key areas where further work could have been done to prepare them further. This information will form part of the collaboration work currently being undertaken by the Western Partnership.

The average length of time homework takes per child varied, consequently this is an area which will be addressed with year 7 teachers and tutors to ensure consistency is achieved.
