









## Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age



## Q7 This school makes sure its pupils are well behaved



### Q8 Has your child been the victim of bullying in the last 12 months?



# Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?



## Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?



### Q11 This school is well led and managed



## Q12 This school responds well to any concerns I raise



# Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress



### Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school



### Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support



### Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?



### Q17 Are you aware of your child's current percentage attendance at school?



# Q18 Are you aware of the grades your child is currently working at in their subjects?



#### Q20 What do you as parents like most about the school?

24 parents responded to the question, giving a wide range of positives about the school. These included; friendly and approachable staff, extra-curricular activities, exceptional communication with swift responses, the ethos and community feel of the school, pastoral care given, progress of students and a safe and protected environment in which children are well looked after.

#### Q21 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

Of the 8 who answered this question, school meal quality, increased ventilation in classrooms, greater communication regarding academic progress, increased opening hours of the library, more homework and practical science and better online learning when children are isolating were noted. In response to these improvement requests, CO2 monitors are placed in classrooms to monitor ventilation and windows/doors are opened. Due to staff absence the library has not

been opened as per its usual opening hours, hopefully with staff returning back to school the library's opening hours will increase. As a school we have termly points of contact with parents to update them on their child's progress, parents can always make contact with their child's tutor should they wish to gain further information. Teachers are requested to upload any work onto their Google Classroom to ensure children who are isolating have work to complete. If a child would like further work, parents can contact their child's tutor who will endeavour to request more work from subject teachers. Learning maps are uploaded onto the school website for students to use as a learning guide when absent. E-portals such as MyMaths and Linguiscope are always available for students to access. There is usually one practical science lesson per week (topic dependant), however the science department are always looking to add more practical elements into their lessons where possible.

#### Q22 Any further comments

1 parent wanted an update on when off-island trips were recommencing, due to the ever changing covid situation this is not yet possible and another praised the Support for Learning team.

#### **Overall Summary**

From the 53 survey responses, it is pleasing to report that over 84% of parents noted their child is happy, safe, well looked after, makes good progress, is taught well and can access online teaching resources. No one disagreed that the school wasn't well led or managed. The majority of parents were aware of their child's current working grades, felt that concerns were responded to, received appropriate homework and had valuable information about the progress they were making.

60% of parents were not aware of their child's percentage attendance. Tutors have been made aware of this and attendance statistics (via a sticker in planners) will be issued to the tutees at the beginning of the next half term.

10 pupils were bullied (including physical, cyber and verbal) and all bar 3 parents noted it was dealt with appropriately. The school has a strict anti-bullying policy as bullying has no place at QEII High School. PSHE lessons, tutor time and assemblies are examples of ways bullying is addressed.

The school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures and review policy as appropriate during the year.
