









Q6 My child receives appropriate homework for their age





Q9 If the answer to the above question is 'Yes', has the school dealt with it effectively?



Q10 If your child has been bullied, what was the nature of the bullying?







Q13 I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress



Q14 My child feels able to study effectively without distraction in school



Q15 The school provides good student wellbeing advice and support



Q16 Would you recommend this school to another parent?



Q17 Are you aware of your child's current percentage attendance at school?



Q18 Are you aware of the grades your child is currently working at in their subjects?



Q20 What do you as parents like most about the school?

32 parents responded to this question. Comments included the great range of extra-curricular activities on offer, a supportive, friendly and fun learning environment, good communication, encouraging teachers, community feel and approachable and proactive staff.

Q21 Is there anything you think we could do to improve the school?

21 parents responded to this question (many noting n/a). Comments included further resources for a dyslexic child, more Isle Listen appointments to be made available, healthier food, improved ventilation, a maths club and bigger lockers. In response; new lockers are on order, CO2 monitors are placed some in classrooms to ensure monitoring takes place, the maths department have been notified of the request and the canteen are reviewing their menu and using social media to make parents aware of how delicious and nutritious their meals are. As a school we work closely with Isle Listen and endeavour to utilise their services where at all possible.

Q21 Any further comments

12 parents answered this question, responses included praise for the support provided by the school, the need for an overview of what levels mean, more positive feedback to students, less homework, parents' evening appointments to be made by staff rather than children and greater discipline for disruptive children. In response to these comments, level descriptor explanations will be emailed to all parents as part of the students' report, postcards home and Key Stage 'student of the week' are used to give positive feedback to students where possible (this is something we will try to encourage more of). The strong majority of parents suggested the levels of homework were appropriate, however if your child is struggling with the amount of homework then please ensure they let their Form Tutor know. With regards to students making parents evening appointments, we use this method to enable your child to liaise with yourselves to ensure the most convenient time is made for you.

Overall Summary

From the 72 survey responses, it is pleasing to report 86% or above of parents note their children are happy, safe, well looked after, taught well, make good progress and receive the appropriate amount of homework. As a result, 90% of parents would recommend the school to others. The majority of parents feel the school is well led and managed, responds to concerns made, receives valuable information about their child's progress and provides good wellbeing and support.

15 parents noted their child had been a victim of verbal or physical bullying, with all bar 2 parents stating the situation had been handled well. There is no place for bullying at QEII High

School, both staff and students work together to support this notion. The school has antibullying ambassadors and a comprehensive anti-bullying policy which it follows.

4 parents stated their child was not able to study effectively without distraction. As a school we have recently undertaken training to increase engagement in the classroom, however if you are concerned that your child cannot study without distraction then we would urge you to contact your child's Form Tutor via enquiries@qe2.sch.im to enable us to deal with any situations that may arise.

66% of respondents agreed that if their child had to self-isolate, they were aware of how to access online learning resources. As we are moving towards living with covid, online learning resources should not be needed to be relied on as heavily. However, if your child does have to self-isolate please instruct them to visit their Google Classrooms and/or our school website to view their curriculum maps. A reminder to students about this will be given during their tutor session.

We appreciate that we can never afford to become complacent and the school will continue to monitor issues through our internal quality assurance procedures.
