KNICKERBOCKERS - You could stuff some pants with fabric all the way round and wear over leggings. STICKY MOUSTACHE/BEARD?! If you can get to a joke shop in time!! THE POOR DIRTY COLOURED TOPS AND LEGGINGS FOR THE BOYS **RAGGEDY SKIRTS AND TATTY SHAWLS FOR THE GIRLS**
