

QEII STUDENT PARKING ARRANGEMENTS – SEPTEMBER 2017

Any student wishing to park on school grounds must have a parking permit. As there is a limited number of student parking spaces (15) priority will be given to those students in Year 13.

Year 12 students can apply for a parking permit, but this will only be issued if there are available spaces.

Permits will only issued to students who have passed the police drive safe course.

PROCESS FOR OBTAINING A PERMIT.

To apply for a parking permit, students must complete the Road Safety Partnership Form (available in the Forster building)

The completed form should go to the School Business Manager along with a copy of your driving licence and insurance document.

Students are also required to attend a Drive Safe Presentation, delivered by local police officers. This will be done at the school and takes approximately 15 – 20 minutes.

The final step in obtaining a parking permit is a vehicle safety check and driving observation again carried out by local police officers.

Once all criteria are met as outline above, a police issued parking permit will be issued. This must be displayed on your dash board when parking on school grounds.

Unfortunately, due to limited spaces, there is no available parking on school grounds for collaboration students. There are various other options available to these students:

1. Use the transport provided (buses)
2. For those who live off main routes, consider park and ride or lift share
3. Park elsewhere, but do be considerate to residents in local areas.
