

SUCCESS CRITERIA: READING ASSESSMENT

TASK: How does Dickens convey the character of Magwitch in the opening of Great Expectations.

Always Looking For (ALF)

Capital letters at the start of the sentence	
Capital letters for names of people and places	
Full stops (exclamations or questions marks) at the end of a sentence	
Key words spelled correctly	
Apostrophes (for omission) in the right place eg don't	
Ideas organised into paragraphs

AF2 – some relevant points made; comments supported by relevant detail or quotation	AF2 most relevant points clearly identified supported by relevant details and quotation
AF3 – works out meaning based on evidence from different points in the text	AF3 – develop explanation of meaning using evidence from text
