Capital letters at the start of the sentence

AF1 – some appropriate ideas; some attempt to develop the ideas a little bit	AF1 – relevant ideas and content chosen; some ideas and developed in detail;
AF2 – some attempts at writing for audience and purpose	AF2 – main purpose clear; style generally appropriate to task
AF3/4 – some attempt to organize ideas;	AF3/4 – ideas are organized simply; paragraphs/sections help to organize the ideas; some attempt to make simple links between paragraphs
AF5/6 – simple sentences usually accurate with full stops, capital letters, question and exclamation marks;	AF5/6 – some variety in length or structure of sentences; tenses generally accurate; punctuation usually accurate, including speech punctuation and commas in lists
AF7 – simple but suitable words chosen	AF7 – some evidence choosing some words for effect
AF8 – correct spelling of common words	AF8 – correct spelling of most common words
